

# A Song About Maria

A Song-telling Game by Mendel Schmiedekamp

To play A Song About Maria, you need a shuffled deck of playing cards with the jokers removed and something to write on this sheet with. You can play solitaire or get a small group together (2-5 others). If you have a group, take turns describing the people in each verse, and take turns describing how each card in the refrain moves each verse forward.

## The Refrain

A Song About Maria has a series of descriptions and card draws which unfold the events of all three verses piece by piece.

- 1) Describe Maria – fill in three adjectives describing Maria.
- 2) Draw a card – this determines how Maria meets someone in each verse
  - ♠ seduction
  - ♣ old friends
  - ♥ fall in love
  - ♦ become friends
- 3) Describe the someones in each verse – filling in a name and three adjectives.
- 4) Maria goes with that someone to a place – draw a card and describe a place that is:
  - ♠ beautiful place
  - ♣ run-down place
  - ♥ exciting place
  - ♦ posh or wealthy place
- 5) Briefly describe the trouble awaiting them in each verse, based on that place.
- 6) Draw a card – this determines what Maria and someone are doing, describe it for each verse.
  - ♠ robbery and/or murder
  - ♣ desperate, risky gamble
  - ♥ having fun, perhaps too much
  - ♦ taking a chance to better themselves
- 7) Draw a card – this determines the fate of that someone, describe it for each verse
  - ♠ murdered by Maria
  - ♣ killed by the Trouble
  - ♥ Maria becomes their lover, for a while.
  - ♦ overcomes the trouble, success!
- 8) Draw a final card and find the most common suit, using this last card's suit in case of a tie – this determines Maria's fate in the last verse:
  - ♠ Maria runs far away.
  - ♣ Maria dies.
  - ♥ Maria gets married.
  - ♦ Maria is happy
